

Ordinance Summary

The Kerala Provisional Collection of Revenues (Amendment) Ordinance, 2020

- The Kerala Provisional Collection of Revenues (Amendment) Ordinance, 2020 was promulgated on July 28, 2020. It amends the Kerala Provisional Collection of Revenues Act, 1985. The Act provides for the immediate effect (for a limited period) of provisions in Bills for giving effect to budget proposals. The Ordinance extends the period for collecting revenue after the passage of the Finance Bill.
- The Act provides for certain provisions in any Bill to have effect: (i) from the date of commencement of the concerned financial year, or (ii) immediately from the date of introduction
- of the Bill. These provisions are related to the imposition/increase of any tax, duty, cess, fee or other revenue that is effected through the passage of the Finance Bill.
- Effect of declaration under the Act: The Act provides that such declared provisions in any Bill will expire: (i) when the provision comes into operation as an enactment (with or without amendment), (ii) when the state government notifies the expiry, or (iii) after 120 days from the date of the Bill coming into force. The Ordinance enhances this limit to 180 days.
