#### L. A. Bill No. XXXII OF 2014.

#### A BILL

further to amend the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994.

WHEREAS both Houses of the State Legislature were not in session;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Maharashtra was satisfied that circumstances existed which rendered it necessary for him to take immediate action further to amend the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, for the purposes hereinafter appearing; and, therefore, promulgated the Maharashtra Universities (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 on the 31st July 2014;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to replace the said Ordinance, by an Act of the State Legislature; it is hereby enacted in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Maharashtra Universities Short title and (Amendment) Act, 2014.
  - (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st July 2014.

2. In the Schedule to the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 Mah. of Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), in Part I, in entry 2, in column XXXV of XXXV of (2), for the words "The University of Pune", the words "The Savitribai Phule 1994. 1994. Pune University" shall be substituted.

Repeal of XVI of 2014 and saving.

3. (1) The Maharashtra Universities (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 is Mah. Mah. Ord. hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken (including any notification or order issued) under the corresponding provisions of the principal Act, as amended by said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done, taken or issued, as the case may be, under the corresponding provisions of the principal Act, as amended by this Act.

#### STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Management Council of the Pune University had, considering the precious and valuable work and as well as great effort and reputation of Smt. Savitribai Phule in the field of Education and especially in the field of Women Education and in order to keep exemplary work and ideas before the future generation, by its resolution, recommended to the State Government to extend the name of the University of Pune as Savitribai Phule Pune University. The Government had also received various representations from the people's representatives in that regard. After considering the said resolution and representations received in that behalf, the State Government considered it expedient to extend the name of the Pune University as the Savitribai Phule Pune University, by amending the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 (Mah. XXXV of 1994) suitably.

- 2. As both Houses of the State Legislature were not in session and the Governor of Maharashtra was satisfied that circumstances existed which rendered it necessary for him to take immediate action further to amend the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 (Mah. XXXV of 1994), for the purposes aforesaid, the Maharashtra Universities (Amendment) Ordinance, 2014 (Mah. Ord. XVI of 2014), was promulgated by the Governor of Maharashtra on the 31st July 2014.
- 3. The Bill is intended to replace the said Ordinance by an Act of the State Legislature.
