#### Short title, extent and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Sikkim Official Languages (Amendment) Act, 2022.
  - (2) It shall extend to the whole of Sikkim.
  - (3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may by notification in the Official Gazette appoint.

# Amendment of section 2

2. In the Sikkim Official Languages Act, 1977, in the long title, the preamble and section 2, after the words "the Sunuwar" the words "the Bhujel" shall be inserted.

#### STATE OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Whereas, the State Government has decided to recognize and include the Bhujel language as one of the official languages of the State.

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-eighth year of the Republic of India by the Legislature of Sikkim, as follows:—

Short title and extent.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Sikkim Official Languages Act
  - (2) It extends to the whole of Sikkim.
  - (3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Languages to be 2. used for the official purposes of the State.

With effect from such date, as the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, specify in this behalf, the Nepali, the Bhutia and the Lepcha languages shall be the languages to be used for all official purposes of the State of Sikkim; Provided that different dates may be specified for different official purposes.
