The undersigned is directed to refer to Department of Personnel & Training's OM No. 11013/9/2014-Estt(A-III) dated 29.04.2020 on the above mentioned subject. The following guidelines stated in the DoPT's OM are to be strictly followed by all employees (regular and outsource) of this Ministry:-

- i. All the officers, staff (including outsourced staff) should download 'Aarogyasetu' App on their mobile phones, immediately.
- ii. Before starting for office, they must review their status on 'Aarogyasetu' and commute only when the app shows 'safe' or 'low risk' status.
- The officers/staff are advised that in case the App shows a message that he/she has a 'moderate' or 'high risk' calculated on the basis of Bluetooth proximity ("recent contact with infected person"), he/she should not come to office and self isolate for 14 days or till the status becomes 'safe' or 'low risk'.
